As a charity, The Palace Trust relies on support from people like you to enable us to continue to open up the Palace and beautiful gardens to members of the public for enjoyment and learning.

Every little helps us to maintain and protect this splendid medieval Palace and its grounds for future generations to enjoy.

By completing a declaration form, The Palace Trust can claim the tax back as part of the Government's Gift Aid Scheme*.

*The Palace Trust can claim back the tax from the Government (currently 25p for each £1 you give), so long as you pay income tax/capital gains tax in the UK at least equal to the amount The Palace Trust will claim back in the appropriate tax year. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief on your self assessment tax return.

I wish The Palace Trust to treat all donations I have made since 6 April 2000 and all donations I make thereafter to be treated as Gift Aid donations. I understand that I must have paid an amount of income tax or capital gains tax equal to the tax the Palace Trust claims on my donations. I will inform the charity if my contact details change or I cease to pay income tax or capital gains tax.
